



Palin changes venue for Monday visit

FORT MYERS: After a change of venue, vice presidential candidate Governor Sarah Palin will be speaking at Germain Arena on Monday.

Palin was originally slated to speak at FGCU's Alico Arena. But because Alico could not accommodate the number of people who wanted to see her, Germain proved to be a better choice.

Officials with Germain Arena confirmed Palin's rally has been moved and say the event is set to start at 3 p.m. But the doors will open at 12:30 p.m.

Because of the venue change, Germain Arena will be cancelling all Everblades events that were supposed to take place Monday.

Germain Arena hold 7,100 people - almost double the number of people Alico Arena could hold.
